Registration of Deaths and Still Births



Current provision

Existing legislation requires family members to attend the registrar in person and report deaths of loved ones in a specified period

New provision

1. The list of authorised informants will now include funeral directors who are authorised by the family

2. Informants will no longer have to attend the registrar in person



What does this mean for you?



Speeds up the process of releasing bodies for burial and funerals/cremation.

Reduces the risks of cross infection during the registration process
