DID YOU KNOW? - TEMPORARY REGISTER

Register will go live now that the Coronavirus Act 2020 has been passed

You can opt out at any time

Coronavirus Act 2020 allows the NMC to create a Covid-19 temporary register

You should have received an email from the NMC on 20 March 2020

If not, please use [the link](#) to let the NMC know that you want to join

DID YOU KNOW - WHO WILL BE REGISTERED?

You have left the register within the last 3 years

NMC will register 'fit, proper and suitably experienced people'

You will need to comply with the Code & work within your scope of practice

No registration fee

DID YOU KNOW? - NURSING AND MIDWIFERY STUDENTS

First Year Undergraduates

They will spend up to 100% of their programme in theory or academic learning. Clinical placements may be paused.

First year students may volunteer or undertake paid work in a clinical setting in their spare time.

Penultimate Year & 1st 6 Months of their Final Year & 1st year Postgraduates

They will be invited to opt in to spend up to 80% of their hours in clinical practice.

They will be paid & it will count towards practice hours as part of their programme.

NURSING Students in their Final Six Months

Emergency Standards will enable them to complete the rest of their training in clinical practice

Next stage of Covid-19 Temporary Register would be to establish a nursing student temporary register. Specific conditions on practice will be in place.

There will NOT be a similar arrangement for midwifery students
