Cancel routine check-ups for patients from vulnerable groups

DID YOU KNOW? - GENERAL NHS GUIDANCE?

Use infection control procedures: wipe down surfaces between patients & use PPE

Agree local arrangements to consolidate essential, routine NHS work & urgent dental problems

Avoid aerosol generating procedures

Do not treat anyone with Covid-19 symptoms or those in their households

Remote Consultations and triage are essential. Remember the three A's: Advice, Analgesia and Antibiotics Before a visit, set up mechanisms to check if patients have symptoms and/or live with someone with symptoms

Clearly display materials on COVID-19

Should be referred to local services, which are being set up, who will have appropriate facilities & PPE
